Dr Wim De Greyt is presently R&D Director at Desmet. He graduated in 1988 as Engineer in Food Technology from the Faculty of Applied Biological Sciences at the University of Ghent, Belgium. He obtained a PhD degree at the same University in 1998 with a study on 'Effect of Physical Refining on Selected Minor Components in Vegetable Oils'.
